BeyondWheels is progressing as planned

Since its launch in October 2025, the project has continued to progress in line with the roadmap agreed by the consortium. The partners have worked in a coordinated manner to develop the BeyondWheels Method, organise international cooperation activities and prepare for the implementation phase with facilitators and beneficiaries.

As of June 2026, the project has successfully achieved all its planned milestones, and training for facilitators is already underway in Spain, Italy and North Macedonia.

Key milestones achieved

- Project **kick-off** event.
- **Transnational project meeting** held in Málaga.
- Development of the **first version of the BeyondWheels Method**.
- **In-person international workshop in Málaga**.
- **Approval of plans** for training and coaching activities for beneficiaries.
- **Recruitment of facilitators and beneficiaries** in the participating countries.

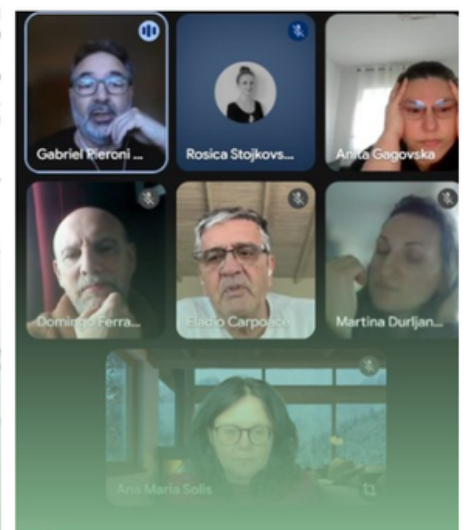
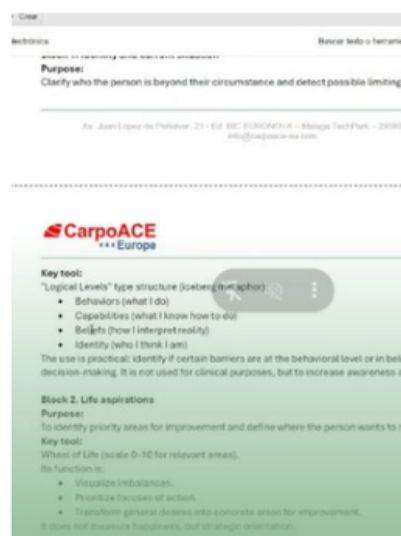
Online discussions about the BeyondWheels method and plans

Over the course of **four online sessions**, the three consortium partners held in-depth discussions on the **draft versions of the BeyondWheels method**, making the changes deemed necessary to produce a version ready for final discussion and approval at the International Workshop in Málaga. During these sessions, they also finalised the **recruitment and implementation plans** for the training of trainers and the training and coaching of beneficiaries with mobility impairments.



In-depth Discussions

The project design proved to have correctly anticipated the **need for prior discussion** of both the BW method (which forms the core upon which everything else is built) and the plans required for the successful delivery of training and coaching activities.

International Workshop in Málaga (Spain)

This international event was organised by **CarpoACE Europe** (project coordinator) in the city of Málaga (Spain), and was attended by two staff members from each of the partners, **Solís Srls** (Italy) and **Poraka Nova** (North Macedonia). **It took place on 4, 5 and 6 May 2026** at the Málaga TechPark.

During the workshop, the latest adjustments made to **the BeyondWheels method** were presented, and **the first version was finalised**, ready for use in training activities for facilitators and participants.

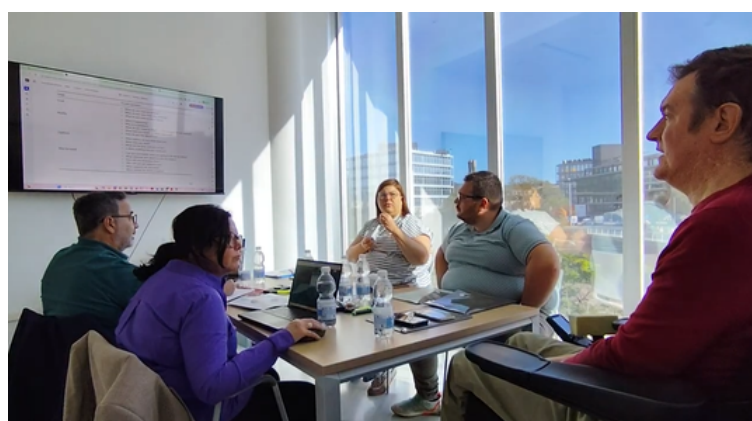
The content of the key tools required to implement these activities was also agreed upon, including the **methodology guide, the facilitator's manual and the online learning platform**.

The participants gave and received **training from one another** in:

- Skills and knowledge required to work effectively with adults with mobility impairments, with a focus on assistive technologies and digital tools.
- How to engage local stakeholders to promote participation and civic engagement in relation to mobility impairments.

The in-person meeting of the consortium partners provided an opportunity to hold a **transnational project meeting** to assess the project's progress and the upcoming milestones to be achieved.

Cultural and team-building activities were also organised throughout the three-day event.

Malaga TechPark

García highlighted the importance of projects such as BeyondWheels, not only for their social impact, but also because they are in line with the initiatives on **social inclusion and innovation** that BIC Euronova actively promotes within Málaga's technology ecosystem and internationally, such as the development of mobility pilot schemes as part of the European SME4 SMARTCITIES project.
